

# SERVICES PROVIDED

## **Community Forums**

- ✓ Regional symposiums on relevant issues related to Substance Use Disorders featuring known professionals in the Behavioral Health field.

## **Outreach**

- ✓ Presentations specifically developed for Middle and High School students and their parents incorporating a wide range of topics related to Substance Use Disorders.

## **Viewpoint**

- ✓ Local Cable Access show airing throughout the region highlighting local public officials, community leaders, professionals and programs supporting health and wellness in our region.

## **Public Service Announcements**

- ✓ Professionally produced 30 second segments are designed to reduce the stigma associated with Substance Use Disorders and bring awareness to the rampant use of heroin within our communities. Airing throughout the region on both Comcast and Fios channel lineups for 6 month increments.

## **Family Navigation Services**

- ✓ Provides assistance to families seeking recovery related services for their loved ones as well as intervening on their behalf with insurance companies and bureaucratic complications.

## **Spotlight Family Support Groups**

- ✓ Bi-weekly guided mutual aid groups facilitated by a qualified health professional meeting at 4 different locations throughout the region (Westchester, Putnam and Dutchess counties).

## **Putnam Jail Education Series**

- ✓ Weekly interactive educational sessions presented by a qualified health professional and designed to give inmates the opportunity to learn more about Substance Use Disorders, Behavioral Wellness and Healthy Strategies to address the spectrum of issues related to mental health and addiction.

## **Early Intervention Program**

- ✓ An interactive educational and experiential age appropriate program designed for young people between 12 and 18 and their parents/guardians who have had initial exposure to alcohol or drug use. The three-hour program involves 2 qualified health professionals and a young person and family member in recovery.

## **Judicial Prevention Program**

- ✓ Interactive educational session designed for young adults between the ages of 18 and 24 who have received violations for alcohol or drug related offenses.

## **Narcan Training**

- ✓ Program to train representatives throughout all segments of the community in the administering of the Opioid antidote. Each attendee receives a kit.
